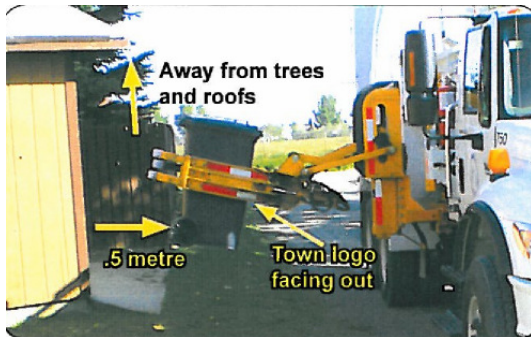


CART PLACEMENT

COMING TO A CURB NEAR YOU!!

BACK ALLEY PLACEMENT:

PARK IT: Place the cart in the back lane as far from trees and other obstacles as possible. Park it on level ground.



POINT IT: Point arrows on the lid toward the center of the alley.

SPACE IT: Allow one meter (three feet) clearance on both sides of the cart and 0.5 meters (1.6 ft) clearance at the back of the cart.

RETURN IT: Take your cart back onto your property by the end of the collection day.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

What NOT to put in your wheeled garbage cart

- Propane cylinders, tires, rocks, sand, heavy materials, automotive batteries, corrosive cleaners, pesticides/herbicides, gasoline, engine oil containers, solvents/thinners, pharmaceuticals/drugs, hot ashes or hot materials and aerosol cans
- Animal carcasses, construction/demolition wastes, household appliances, furniture, electronics and tires

HOW TO USE YOUR GARBAGE BIN

CART PLACEMENT

Step ONE: Record your serial number

- Each bin comes with a unique serial number that is specific to your address. Please make record of this in case your bin is stolen or damaged; it will help us to identify it.

Step TWO: Follow the program

- The same regulations apply to the new automated system for bagging your garbage. Bag and tie all your household waste. All your waste must fit in the cart and the lid must close. No additional waste will be collected.
- Set your cart out by 7:00 a.m. on the day of pick-up at your specified location (front curb or back alley).
- Please put your cart away by 7:00 p.m. and store it in a secure area until the next pick-up.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Residents are responsible for the cleaning and safe storage of their cart.
- If your cart is damaged or stolen, call the Town of Drumheller immediately so we can get you a replacement cart

Please Note: It is the responsibility of the homeowner to care for the cart and he/she will be required to pay for a replacement cart if damages/loss is the result of negligence.

Step THREE: Cart Placement

How you place your cart is very important. The automated collection arm requires room to grab it. Please ensure that your cart is clear from all obstacles such as parked cars, poles, hedges, ect. and does not block traffic.

FRONT CURB PLACEMENT

PARK IT: Place wheels 50 cm (1.6 ft.) from the front curb. Park it on level ground.



POINT IT: Point arrows on the lid toward the center of the road.

SPACE IT: Allow one meter (three feet) clearance on both sides of the cart and 0.5 meters (1.6 ft) clearance at the back of the cart.

RETURN IT: Take your cart back onto your property by the end of the collection day.
