**DRUMHELLER & DISTRICT REGIONAL LANDFILL  
DISPOSAL POLICIES**

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1. Disposal fees are in effect at the Drumheller & District Regional Landfill, Please ensure you have sufficient funds before entering the Landfill.
2. The Operations Manager or their designate will be the sole judge as to the classification and source of refuse delivered to the Drumheller & District Regional Landfill. Landfill attendants will inspect the loads to determine classification of the refuse. Identification may be required to verify the source. The decision of the Operations Manager is final.
3. 100 kgs./week of household waste will be accepted free of charge, 101-250 kgs of household waste will be charged a flat fee of \$5.00, 250 kgs and up will be charged \$40.00 /metric tonne.
4. Demolition waste is charged based on the following policy: 1 – 150 kgs= \$5.00, 150 kgs – 250 kgs = \$10.00. Over 250 kgs will be charged \$45.00/metric tonne
5. Where mixed loads are involved the Operations Manager or their designate shall be the sole judge of the rate to be applied for disposal, which will generally be based on the type of material with the highest applicable rate.
6. Customers with mixed loads, please, separate and dispose of your waste, at individual disposal areas, as directed.
7. Licensed and Non- Licensed vehicle tires from within the region are accepted free of charge if the tires are counted, sorted according to size, and stacked in the applicable piles or placed in the supplied bin. Failure to comply will result in a \$65.00/metric tonne charge.
8. Concrete and Asphalt (separated) is accepted free of charge as long as there is no other debris co-mingled in the load. The concrete can be no larger than 3' by 3', the material must be able to fit into a crushing machine otherwise the demolition rate applies.
9. Disposal of large livestock and domestic animals from commercial veterinarians and ranchers are required to pay \$5.00/animal. Road kill and the general public with domestic animals are not required to pay a disposal fee. The Drumheller & District Regional Landfill no longer accepts dead cattle due to additional standards implemented by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency.
10. Compost, such as lawn clippings, leaves and small trees and branches are free of charge, however large caliper tree stumps & trunks (too large to cut for fire wood and stumps which will not decompose for hundreds of years) are charged at a rate of \$45.00/tonne with a minimum of \$5.00.
11. Waste water from manholes, culverts and underground lines will be disposed of at a rate of \$50.00/ truck load, this type of waste is unacceptable for the sewage treatment facility.
12. 24 hour advance notice is required for disposal of hard to handle wastes. The Operations Manager or their designate will be the sole judge as to what requires special handling.
