YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT...

- One (1) completed copy of a **Building or Gas Permit(s) Application Form** and include information on:
 - Make and Model of Fireplace/Stove
 - Type of Fuel
 - Please allow 7 - 10 working days for processing of your Building Permit

METAL FIREPLACES (Solid Fuel Burning)

All Factory built fireplace assemblies require a building permit and must be installed as per the Alberta Building Code. The installation of a Solid Fuel Fireplace must be inspected by a Safety Codes Officer in the Building Discipline (Building Inspector).

In order to ensure minimum fire safety standards, all factory-built fireplaces are required to have an Underwriters' Laboratories of Canada (ULC) or other approved certification label which specifies that the entire assembly has been tested as a unit in accordance with the current CAN/ULC Standard for "Factory-Built Fireplaces".

Factory-built fireplace assemblies must be installed as per the manufacture's instructions.

A building permit cannot be issued for Solid Fuel fireplaces which have not been tested to or meets with the CAN/ULC Standards for "Factory-Built Fireplaces".

METAL FIREPLACES (Gas Burning)

All gas burning metal fireplace assemblies require a gas permit and must be installed as per the Gas Code. The installation of a gas-burning Fireplace must be inspected by a Safety Codes Officer in the Gas Discipline (Gas Inspector).

In order to ensure minimum safety standards, all factory-built gas burning fireplaces are required to be approved by Underwriters' Laboratories of Canada (ULC), the Canadian Gas Association (CGA) or other approved testing agency.

Factory-built fireplace assemblies must be installed as per the manufacture's instructions.

A gas permit cannot be issued for any gas-burning fireplaces which has not been approved by an approved testing agency.

STOVES (Solid Fuel Burning)

Solid Fuel Burning Stove assemblies require a building permit and must be installed as per the Alberta Building Code. The installation of a Solid Fuel Burning Stove must be inspected by a Safety Codes Officer in the Building Discipline (Building Inspector).

All Solid Fuel Burning Stoves are required to have an approved certification label which specifies that the unit conforms to current acceptable standards.

Factory-built stove assemblies must be installed as per the manufacture's instructions.

A building permit cannot be issued for any solid fuel burning stove which has not been approved by an approved testing agency.

INSTALLATION OF METAL FIREPLACES OR STOVES IN MODULAR OR MOBILE HOMES.

The installation of any appliance such as a Metal Fireplace or Stove in a modular or manufactured home must be tested specifically for that installation. The manufactures' specifications may indicate that the appliance is acceptable for that purpose. For further information on the appliance contact the manufacturer of the appliance.
