TENDER FOR DRUMHELLER SOLID WASTE COLLECTION CONTRACTS 2010 – 2014

ARMY RESERVE TO EXERCISE IN THE TOWN OF DRUMHELLER

Members of the public are to be advised that military training will be conducted within the Town of Drumheller and the Municipal District of Starland, during the weekend of March 19-21st. Training will begin with the arrival of soldiers at approximately 12:00pm on Friday March 19th and ending at approximately noon on Sunday March 21st. The training will be based out of the airport and will take place in various areas around town. There will be an information booth set up at the Worlds Largest Dinosaur. The exercise will focus on developing the soldiers ability to interact with the populace in a non confrontational manner and learn how to operate in a contemporary urban environment. The Training will consist of soldiers carrying rifles, both on foot and in vehicles and helicopters. Portions of this training will also involve the use of blank training ammunition, so sounds of gunfire may be heard in the area on Sunday March 21st. The local RCMP detachment is aware that this training activity is taking place.

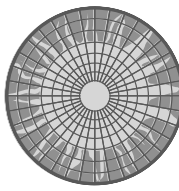
