## BY-LAW

Drumheller Community Enforcement is focusing on pedestrian safety over the winter months as our roads and sidewalks become more difficult to navigate do to falling snow and development of ice over the winter months.

During this time, DCE officers, as part of their regular “in partnership” initiatives will be proactively patrolling the Town. Sidewalks will be inspected for breaches under the Traffic Bylaw. No obstructions may be placed on or across the sidewalk including extension cords providing the said cord is or medium is at a height of not less than seven (7) feet above such sidewalk and is firmly fastened to solid objects at the height of seven (7) feet on both sides of the sidewalk.

During their patrols, officers may identify other concerns in the Community and address them accordingly. In all cases, the officers will inform then enforce focusing on community safety. Your Community Cooperation is appreciated.
